Excerpt from the Bakersfield Association of Professional Landmen By-Laws

ARTICLE V - MEMBERSHIP

Section 1. Membership categories in the Association shall be:

Active Membership

Active membership shall be open to any applicant, regardless of compensation or title, who is primarily and regularly engaged as a professional landman in the acquisition, maintenance and/or supervision of oil, gas and/or mineral leases, contracts and titles relating to the exploration and development of such oil, gas and other natural resources.

Associate Membership

Associate membership shall be open to persons who are either (1) associated with land work relating to oil, gas or other mineral exploration and exploitation, or (2) are first-year graduates of a Petroleum or Mineral Land Studies or Management Program at a recognized college or university and are not employed in a position as a professional landman sufficient to otherwise obtain an Active or Associate Membership status. The application of any such graduate must be signed by the Program Coordinator. The Associate Member shall have all the rights and privileges of active members.

Student Membership

Student membership shall be open to persons enrolled full time in a Petroleum or Mineral Land Students or Management program at a recognized college or university. The student application must be signed by the Program Coordinator. Student Membership status is not valid upon graduation. Student members shall have all the rights and privileges of active members except those of voting and holding office or chairmanship of any committee.

Life Membership

Life membership shall be open to past presidents and any person who has attained the age of sixty-five and has been active in any Landmen's Association for the last five years prior to his sixty-fifth birthday. Life members shall enjoy all rights and privileges of active members and shall be exempt from the payment of dues. Life members shall be listed annually in the BAPL Membership Directory by annual completion of a Membership Data Sheet.

Honorary Life Membership

Honorary Life Membership may be conferred by the Executive Committee upon any person who has rendered an outstanding contribution to the oil and gas industry and/or this Association and shall have the same rights and privileges as Life members.

Section 2. Applications

All applications for membership shall be submitted on an approved form and accompanied by the appropriate annual dues set forth in Article XI below. The completed form shall contain sufficient information for the Executive Committee to place the applicant in the proper membership category. The application form shall also provide opportunity for the applicant to express specific areas of interest and contribution to the advancement of the Association. No application shall be considered until it is signed by two (2) Active, Life or Honorary Life Members who are personally acquainted with the applicant.

New Membership Sponsors

The undersigned, as Active Members of the Bakersfield Association of Landmen, are personally acquainted with the applicant for new membership (or reclassification of membership status) and attest to his/her qualifications, job experience, and ethical conduct. The undersigned further state that the applicant is fully qualified for membership in the noted classification.
